- Apply a thin coat of FloorCare satin and allow to dry.
- Allow 3 days curing before using any cleaners or maintenance products on freshly applied FloorCare satin

RECOMMENDATION FOR ENGINEERED WOOD FLOORING:

Due to the multidude of available engineered wood flooring types in combination with different finish qualities we recommend to also refer to the Care instructions of the manufacturer.
